### **1. REVIEW OF THE PREVIOUS ACTIVITIES: THE COLLABORATIVE BOOK.**

The December activity is to create a collaborative book with the research carried out by the students after visiting the natural park in their area. The online tool "Story jumper" will be used.

The Spanish team has already prepared its part and uploaded it to the collaborative book. The Italian and Greek teams have already prepared the information with the investigations carried out by the students. They only need to upload the information to the collaborative book. They will do them in the next few days.

The Romanian team has not yet prepared this activity. He will do it with the students after the holidays, in January. Some teachers (Dorina and Sorina) have had problems accessing the application. The coordinator Venera has accessed the collaborative book without problems, so if necessary she will take care of uploading the information. It explains how to access the application and they will try again. If necessary, gmail accounts will be sent to the coordinator Tania to generate new invitations.



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## **2. ACTIVITIES FOR JANUARY: TRAINING WORKSHOP ON “RENEWABLE ENERGY SOURCES”**

In Spain, Italy and Greece this activity will take place in January. The workshop is already being prepared. At first, an attempt will be made to find external experts, but if this is not possible, it will be organized from the center.

The Romanian team has already prepared this activity and they have done the training with the help of Professor Crina, an expert in geography. It was done inside the school. In addition, they have already posted the photos on the project page.

## **3. FEBRUARY ACTIVITIES.**

- **Solidarity Market.** Each school will carry out a solidarity market with the objects Recycled created last month. The money obtained it will be donated to an NGO that works to improve the environment.

The Romanian team has already carried out this activity also during the month of December. They have prepared and carried out the market and with the money obtained they have made a donation to a local NGO that takes care of the environment.

Spain is preparing the market for the month of February. Depending on the COVID situation, it will be face-to-face or virtual. The materials have been collected throughout these months of work, they are crafts made by the students (magnets, stickers, coasters, pendants ...)

Greece also already has all the material collected while waiting to set up the market, initially in person, where families can go to buy their crafts. Italians have more problems with this, since currently families cannot access the center, so it will be done virtually at first.

- Each school will write an **article** to the local press explaining the initiative and collaboration with the NGO.
- **Prepare mobility to Greece.**

Greece is already finishing preparing the program of activities for the week of March 14th-18th. As soon as they have it, they send it to us. They have already sent information about the hotel to reserve the rooms. Just as they have the invitation letters ready. Starting in January, Romania, Spain and Italy will send the full names of the participants. A forecast of who is going to travel is asked:

- Italy: 2 boys and 2 girls of 13 years. Probably with 2 teachers. Now they are searching for the substitutes students.
- Romania: 4 girls of fourth grade with probably 2 teachers.
- Spain: 5 girls and 1 boy (plus 1 extra boy, son of one teacher) with 3 teachers (Raúl, Tania and Sonia Reche)



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- Prepare mobility to Italy.

Italy is also preparing the program of activities for the week of April 4th-8th. A forecast of who is going to travel is asked again:

- Greece: 2 boys and 2 girls. Probably with 2 teachers (María and María Petropoulou)
- Romania: 2 students of fourth grade and 2 students of sixth grade, with 2 teachers (Crina and Livia)
- Spain: 4 girls and 2 boys with 3 teachers (Marta, Sonia and María)

#### 4. NEXT MEETING.

- Italy proposes to hold a meeting with the students who participated in the mobility in Spain, so that they can see each other again and have a Merry Christmas. We all agree. The link will be created by a Spanish teacher for tomorrow, **Wednesday December 22 at 10 am** (Spanish and Italian time) by Google Meet. The Greek and Romanian teams are organizing to participate.
