## **2. MARCH ACTIVITY.**

The activity for the month of March is the celebration of water day with the elaboration of a decalogue on its responsible use. It is proposed to develop a joint presentation collaboratively through the CANVAS application. All members of this meeting agree. The coordinator has already created the online document and has uploaded the link on Twinspace (she will also send it to all the teachers) so that they can work with their students and upload the images of the work they have done. Each country has editing permission and as many pages as needed can be added.

Also during the month of March, we have to complete the documents for the follow-up of the project activities. The link is also on Twinspace (and the coordinator will send it to everyone by mail). Once the documents are completed, they must be signed by the director of each school and bear the school's seal. Said document must be scanned and sent to the coordinator of the project. It is dated before the end of March.

## **3. APRIL ACTIVITY.**

The activity for the month of April is the recording of spots to promote the care of our planet. Similar to the ones we recorded during mobility in Spain. Students must record themselves promoting the care of the planet.

The Romanian coordinator asks about the possibility of showing the faces of the students (due to data protection). As long as you have permission from the families, you can, but in any case, it is not mandatory.

## **4. MAY ACTIVITY.**

The coordinator of the project also explains the activity in May, so that each country can organize itself as best it can to carry it out, since we find ourselves with the three mobilities very close together between April and May. This month's activity consists of the creation of a collaborative Padlet where students can write (in English) their opinions and evaluations of the project. This way they will also be able to see the opinions of students from other countries. The coordinator will create and send the link in the next few days.

## **5. JUNE ACTIVITY.**

In previous meetings there was talk of the activity for the month of June, which is the creation of the second issue of the eTwinning magazine. It was decided to have until March 4 for the magazine cover drawings (of which one will be selected per country) and until April 28 to deliver the articles (in English and in the mother tongue).
