#### 2. QUESTIONS ABOUT SPANISH MOBILITY.

- <u>Europass document:</u> It is a document that the students involved in the mobility have to complete. It helps them so that in the future they can include it in their CV as an academic achievement. It is completed differently in each country, in Spain it is done online.
- The best way to get to the hotel from the airport is by taxi, although there is a bus (number 824). The Spanish coordinator will be in charge of booking taxis, for this you need the hours and flight numbers for each country.
- Each country has to <u>pay</u> its share. The Spanish school will issue the necessary invoices with the data provided by the Erasmus schools.
- Due to the current COVID situation, all students are going to take a <u>PCR</u> test before coming to Spain (although it is only mandatory for Romania) But they are going to do it for prevention.
- A separate <u>WhatsApp group</u> will be created with the teachers directly involved in the mobility in order to
  have direct communication during their stay that does not bother the rest of the teachers who do not
  participate in the mobility.
- Meals, as well as mid-morning lunches on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday are included. And
  so is Wednesday dinner at the farm. For the mid-morning luncheon on Friday, students will need to bring
  something. It can be purchased Thursday afternoon. Dinners on Sunday, Monday, Tuesday and Thursday
  are the responsibility of each of the countries and are carried out independently. The host school (Spain)
  will invite you to dinner on Friday.
