1. ERASMUS ACTIVITIES

- Advertisements for the environment. Greece and Spain have already sent theirs. It is only missed the Italian and Romanian advertisements. Matilde explains that during the mobility in Italy, the day we climbed Vesuvius, we prepared a collaborative advertisement with all the students from the four countries with different slogans about caring for the environment. It is sent to Tania during the development of this video call and we visualize it. Some comments are made regarding the protection of children's data and it is indicated that some children are missing in the video, likewise it is recalled that we made a final message all together to include the announcement as a closing. The necessary modifications will be made and it will be resubmitted to be published on the project website and on eTwinspace. With this it would be worth it. Romania, if they have time, want to prepare more personalized ones, they will try.
- It is necessary to complete the <u>Padlet</u> of the project in which the comments of the students on the activities carried out during these two years of Erasmus are collected. Romania and Spain have already done so, Greece and Italy are missing. He wonders if it is an activity that is in a hurry and it is explained that it is going to be presented for the accreditation of the eTwinning project with which it all started.
- It is wondered how Italy is doing with the organization of the <u>solidarity market</u>. They have allowed them to organize it in a classroom and for the children to go by one by one to buy. When they have it done they will let us know.











- Spain is in charge of setting up the <u>magazine</u> with all the articles that have been sent to it from the four colleges. As soon as it's ready, he'll show it to us.
- Pupils and teachers have to respond to the <u>evaluation of the eTwinning project</u>. You can find the links in eTwinspace, in the tab corresponding to evaluation. There are different links for students and teachers.
- We are going to apply for the <u>eTwining Label</u>. It is necessary to fill out a document. The coordinator tells us how to do it. It is requested by the four schools separately, each in their mother tongue.
- In Romania we will receive the following <u>letter from Dumbledore</u> thanking all the effort made and giving us the last clue to open the Cryptex. The letter will be carried by Hedwig along with a small gift for each school from Dumbledore. With this we will have all the clues and we can start thinking about the Cryptex solution.
 - 1. "The word which opens the cryptex is connected with a triangle"
 - 2. "A teacher who is not what he seems to be"
 - 3. "Expecto Patronum"
 - 4. "Lili Potter"
 - 5. "The clue is a word"
 - 6 (and new) "After all this time? ..."
- In June, probably in Greece, we will receive the <u>last letter from Dumbledore</u>. In it, he will remind us of all the clues and will encourage us to discover the key to open the Cryptex. For this, it is proposed to organize an Escape Room. The students will discover the word to open the Cryptex with the clues we have ("ALWAYS") Inside the Cryptex there will be a map with the location of 5 gems (geodes) The students will have to look for them and break them to release the evil that they contain inside and defeat thus to Dumbledore.
- On Sunday June 5th we will celebrate <u>Environment Day</u>. We will do it with a campaign in favour of the use of bicycles. In Spain we have prepared bicycle trips with the students along the cycle path near the school. Each country will organize itself to the best of its ability.
- It is necessary to complete the <u>students and teachers impact of the project</u>. It must be done before school finish in June (although it is scheduled for September) because many students leave for high school and will not be able to do it later. Links to do so were sent in a previous email in March.
- It is also necessary to carry out the <u>dissemination</u>, <u>risk and monitoring activities</u>. This task can be done by teachers during the months of July or August, it has to be done by September.
- Likewise, the coordinator will prepare the <u>Final report</u> in the months of July and August, to send it in September.











2. ROMANIAN MOBILITY

The Romanian coordinator specifies certain details regarding the trip to Romania:

- Meals on May 9, 11 and 13 will be in a restaurant in Bistrita with a menu (starter, main course, drink and dessert) for approximately 10 euros.
- Dinners are free, but he wonders if we'll have Sunday dinner together when we get there. They are going to try to organize it for us to do it at the hotel (where it costs about 12.12 euros per person) Greece arrives very late so they will have dinner on their own and we will see them on Monday morning.
- Meals on the 10th and 12th will be outside of Bistrita. On Tuesday a menu of 10 euros per person is calculated, and on Thursday of 12 euros per person. At lunch and dinner you can pay by card and get a separate receipt by country, you have already consulted.
- Regarding transport from the airport, it has been contracted for Greece and Spain with a small company in the area. It costs about 80 euros, although Spain, being more people, will have to pay more. These payments must be made in cash. Italy asks if Romania could prepare their transport from the airport too.
- The climate at first oscillates between 10 and 20 degrees. With a light coat it would be worth it. It is recommended to bring 2 pairs of shoes because it rains some days.

4. GREEK MOBILITY

Spain already has the tickets bought and the hotel paid for. He has sent the information to the Greek team that has been in charge of managing the airport transport. A welcome dinner is also agreed on the Sunday that you land. All countries are invited and as soon as they have their flights, their transport will be managed.

- From Italy: Letizia and Silveria. If possible, Matilde will also accompany them, she is managing it.

Next week we will be informed of the costs of lunch and dinner; as well as the doubt of the card payment will be resolved.

They tell us that on Thursday's excursion there is the option of going up to the highest part in a kind of funicular, but for this it is necessary that the teachers carry a COVID recovery or full vaccination certificate. These data will be confirmed later. In addition, on May 1, the COVID measures for entering the country will be reviewed. Right now it is necessary for adults who have the Green Pass with the complete vaccination schedule or a negative result of a PCR test.

They are also trying to organize the pairs of students, so that they can begin to prepare. Italy is asked for the student questionnaires. They will send them tomorrow.
