1. ERASMUS ACTIVITIES

- The Romanian team have to prepare a document explaining the results of the final questionaries of the mobility. This information must be published also on the project webpage.
- Italy is organization the solidarity market.
- All the countries need to prepare a video about the Romanian mobility, to upload on the Erasmus project webpage.
- Spain has request the quality label of this project and some of the Spanish participants had already received the Quality Label. The other countries are in process.
- Greek teachers ask for a picture of Spanish, Romanian and Italian teachers involved in this mobility.

2. GREEK MOBILITY

The following teachers participate in this trip to Greece:

- From Spain: Tania, Raúl and María.
- From Romania: Sorina and Irina Matei.
- From Italy: Letizia and Silveria. Matilde will also accompany them.











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All the Greek mobility is already planned. They explain some aspects.

- The Greek team had made a reservation for a dinner on Sunday afternoon at 8 pm.
- The Spanish team is informed that the bus from the airport need to be paid by cash. Also all the participants are informed that also the snack and lunch at school must be paid by cash (on Tuesday and Wednesday) other meals, dinners ... can be both paid by cash or credit card.
- Maybe the schedule of Monday may change a bit, starting earlier than it was programme, because so many classes at the Greek school wants to participate on the welcoming.
- Hotel reservation are perfect. Breakfast starts at 6:30 am.
- The weather usually is very hot and sunny. But this week it has been raining. They will give us more detailed information next week.
- It is recommended to bring fresh clothes and jacket, raincoat, comfortable shoes and long trousers. It is also suggested to bring swimsuit.
- Spanish team needs PCR or antigenic test 24 hours before arrived at Spain. This test can be done at any pharmacy. Greek team will ask near the hotel so the two teachers can take antigenic test (with results in English) on Saturday morning before leaving the city.

3. CRYPTEX ACTIVITY.

All schools need to bring their cryptex to mobility in Greece as they are needed for the final activity. In this activity, students will be divided into four international teams and each will be given a cryptex. Solving the clues will open the cryptex. Inside they will find a rhyme, riddle, clue... that will take them to a part of the school.

Upon arrival, they will find a puzzle piece that they must take to collect with the other teams. Together they will assemble the puzzle and discover a special location of the Greek school (probably in the orchard).

When they get there, they will find the geodes that they will have to break to destroy the horcruxes and defeat Voldemort. Then they will have a QR code that when scanned will allow them to see a video where it is seen how Voldemort dies defeated and the Earth is saved.

Everyone agrees with this activity.

The video call where the students who are going to participate in the mobility to Greece will introduce themselves, will take place as scheduled next **Tuesday**, **May 24**th at 6:00 pm.
